Each batch of our gin is vapor distilled in 100 gallon batches, ensuring that the final product is both complex and well-balanced. Boot Hill Gin features juniper, coriander, bitter orange peel, angelica root, orris root, licorice root, chamomile blossoms and just a tiny dash of sarsaparilla. It's brash and smooth enough to earn the Boot Hill name.

NOSE: This first nosing is incredibly leafy, vine-like, and vegetal, like a newly tilled garden.

NEAT: : Intensely earthy. Midpalate brings with it a wave of savory, tangy, bittersweet flavor thrust that launches the juniper into the picture.

ON THE ROCKS: Citrus and earthiness moves to the front, juniper underlines on the back palate followed by bitter orange and quick hits of sweetness.
